2. The examination will be conducted in accordance with the "Rules for the Examinations of Masters and Mates". Candidates should submit their applications on Form Exn. 2 (Pak) duly filled in carefully, together with supporting documents such as:

- a) Valid Sight Test Certificate, (Letter Test/Lantern Test), valid for two years.
- b) Result of Examination (original) OR
Copy of "Notice of Eligibility" issued to the candidate by the examiner (if appearing first time)
- c) Three photographs (facial front view) of applicant), without uniform taken within a year preceding application, with applicant's signature and name printed on reverse side. Photos should be coloured and 1.5x1.5" (36 mm x 36 mm) in size with blue background to be attached with application form.

- d) Candidates for Class-II Deck Exams must indicate clearly in the application form in which Block of written exams they want to appear.

Following additional qualifying conditions are to be met before first time appearing in the examination as per NOE issued.

Applicable to Class-1 and Class-2 candidates.(II/2 of STCW-78)

1. Valid General Operating Certificate for GMDSS;
2. Radar & ARPA Navigation – Management Level Certificate;
3. Medical Care Certificate; and
4. ECDIS – Management Level

Applicable to Class-3 and/or Class-4 Candidates.(II/1 of STCW-78)

1. Valid General Operating Certificate for GMDSS;
2. Radar & ARPA Navigation – Operational Level Certificate;
3. Medical First Aid certificate;
4. Certificate of Proficiency in Survival Craft and Rescue Boats;
(other than fast rescue boats)
5. Efficient Deck Hand certificate;
6. Advanced Fire Fighting certificate; and
7. ECDIS – Operational Level

3. The candidates are to pay the prescribed fee, to the PRINCIPAL OFFICER, MERCANTILE MARINE DEPARTMENT, KARACHI, at least 20 days before the commencement of examination i.e. on 12 March, 2022, 11 June, 2022, 17 September, 2022 and 17 December 2022.
