Maritime Training Institutes in the public and private sector conducting GP-III training approved by the Ministry of Maritime Affairs are hereby informed that the GP-III examination is scheduled to be held at Mercantile Marine Department, Karachi, on 13 June 2022 at 09:00 Hrs.

- 2. (i) The Institutes are advised to submit application forms for the candidates of session June 2022 and those who were failed/absent since June 2020 along with the examination fee at Mercantile Marine Department on or before 23rd May 2022.
 - * (ii) Application forms for candidates before December 2019 may be submitted with revision classes courses certificates of at least four weeks along with examination fees at MMD.
- 3. Application forms may be submitted till **03-06-2022** along with late fees.
- 4. Candidates have to show their identity at the time of entering the examination hall and are advised to bring their **Original Computerized National Identity Cards** and Photo Identity Card issued by their Institute, as proof, at the time of entering the Examination Hall.
- 5. Please note the following are the requirements to be fulfilled along with Application Forms for examination;
 - a. The age of new candidates for the June 2022 examination should be between 18 to 25 on 1st January 2022. If any candidate for examination is overage or underage or

the above-mentioned date then he must provide an age-condoned letter from the competent authority.

- b. Latest photographs (after induction in a course) of the candidate to be pasted on the Application Form and the same photograph to be pasted on the certificate, if a candidate passes the said examination.
- c. Photocopy of GP-III attendance register of the session should be submitted to the undersigned as soon as the classes for the current course are completed.
- d. Matric Certificate verification of the candidate is the responsibility of the institute and the status of verification should be mentioned in the Application Form.
- e. The spelling of the Candidate's name, date of birth, and CNIC number should be correctly printed in the Application Form and the same should be written in the list (Soft and Hard copy) submitted by Institute.
- 6. Institute are directed to send one of their instructor/representatives at the Examination Center and should remain there during examination for any information/confirmation about the candidate(s)
- 7. <u>Mobile phones are Strictly Prohibited</u> in the Examination Hall, the institutes are directed to advise their candidates accordingly.
- 8. <u>Certificate of the successful candidates shall be issued after passing the sights</u> and vision test at Mercantile Marine Department.
- 9. <u>All institute Heads are advised to please read the above instructions carefully and ensure compliance.</u>
